SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- The applicant must be a Greek Orthodox Christian (baptized or chrismated in the Greek Orthodox religion) and affiliated (e.g., through Sunday School attendance, service to the church or other church-related activities) with the Saint Sophia Greek Orthodox Cathedral of Washington, D.C.
- The applicant will graduate high school by the end of the current school year and is accepted to and will attend an accredited college or university in fall 2025.

Or

• The applicant is an undergraduate student already enrolled in an accredited college or university who will be continuing undergraduate studies in fall 2025.

Or

• The applicant is a graduate student who is accepted to and will attend or will be continuing graduate studies in an accredited college or university graduate program in fall 2025.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED BY APRIL 4, 2025.

- 1) Completed copy of this application form
- 2) Most current school transcript including grade point average (GPA)
- 3) Letter(s) of recommendation
- 4) Essay responding to one choice of writing prompts provided
- 5) Proof of acceptance to or enrollment in an accredited college or university
- 6) Resume

PART 2: SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT

Along with your application, attach a copy of your most recent school transcript including GPA.

PART 3: LETTER(S) OF RECOMMENDATION

Attach at least one (or two) letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or professor.

PART 4: ESSAY

Attach an original essay (between 300-500 words) you have written in response to **one** of the four following prompts:

- 1) How does the Greek Orthodox faith affect your daily life?
- 2) What do you think the Greek Orthodox Church could do to inspire more youth to become involved in the Church?
- 3) How have you personally fulfilled any part of the mission of Philoptochos?
- 4) Reflect on a time when you questioned or challenged a belief of your Orthodox faith. What prompted your thinking and what was the outcome?

PART 5: PROOF OF ACCEPTANCE OR ENROLLMENT IN A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY

Attach a copy of your letter or acceptance or documentation of your continuing enrollment in an accredited college or university for the next school year.

PART 6: RESUME

Attach your current resume, including extracurricular activities, honors, awards and volunteer and community service.
